

Moscato Giallo (Goldmuskateller) is the prime grape variety to be found in the Maso Warth estate, heart of the Moser family winery. Its hilly landscape, gravelly soil, natural south-westerly aspect, and the "Ora del Garda" – the wind that in summer blows regularly north from Lake Garda: these elements make of this a unique place for growing Moscato Giallo grapes.

appellation:	IGT Vigneti delle Dolomiti Moscato Giallo.
grape variety and vineyards:	Moscato Giallo (Goldmuskateller), sourced on the hills of Maso Warth, north of Trento, at an altitude of 350 - 400 metres.
average vineyard age:	15 - 25 years.
soil:	Limestone.
winemaking:	Hand-harvested with careful selection of the best bunches in the vineyard, fermentation followed by ageing on its fine lees for 6 months in stainless steel tanks to enhance the typical freshness and aromatic character of this variety.
tasting notes:	Straw-yellow colour with golden highlights. Full and pleasant bouquet with a very intense aromatic note of muscat. Fresh taste with hints of ripe fruit.
average production:	10.000 bottles/year.
