MOSCATO GIALLO

Moscato Giallo (Goldmuskateller) is the prime grape variety to be found in the Maso Warth estate, heart of the Moser family winery. The hilly landscape, gravelly soil, natural south-westerly aspect, and the "Ora del Garda" – the wind that in summer blows regularly north from Lake Garda: these elements make this a unique place for growing Moscato Giallo grapes.



appellation:

IGT Vigneti delle Dolomiti Moscato Giallo.

grape variety and vineyard location:

Moscato Giallo (Goldmuskateller), sourced on the hills of Maso Warth, North of Trento, at an altitude of 350 - 400 metres.

average vineyard age:

15 - 25 years.

soil:

Limestone.

winemaking:

Hand-harvested with careful selection of the best bunches in the vineyard, fermentation followed by ageing on its fine lees for 6 months in stainless steel tanks to enhance the typical freshness and aromatic character of this variety.

tasting note:

Straw-yellow colour with golden highlights. Full and pleasant bouquet with a very intense aromatic note of muscat. Fresh taste with hints of ripe fruit.

production:

6,000 bottles.
