2024

"Rhine Riesling" is a white grape variety, originating in the German Moselle region. Its typical traits are found in its perfectly balanced acidity, sweetness and alcohol content. In the Maso Warth estate, this grape variety is grown on a hill close to the ancient bishop's residence, at an altitude of 400 m, in a vineyard facing North that was specifically selected to enhance this variety's characteristics.



appellation:

DOC Trentino Riesling Renano.

grape variety and vineyard location:

Riesling grapes, sourced on the hills of Maso Warth, North of Trento, at an altitude of 400 metres.

average vineyard age / soil:

20 years / Limestone.

winemaking:

Hand-harvested with careful selection of the best bunches. Half of the wine is fermented and then aged on its fine lees in stainless steel tanks; the rest in 25 hL oak casks. Bottled in summer and then bottle-aged for a further year.

tasting notes:

Straw yellow colour with greenish highlights. The nose is fresh with typical tertiary hydrocarbon notes. The mouth is pleasantly sapid with a persistent finish.

vintage notes:

The 2024 vintage was marked by significant climatic variability, with frequent rainfall, at times stormy in nature, in the early summer. In contrast, in the late summer and early autumn the weather was stable and sunny, which allowed the grapes to ripen fully while preserving its acidity, sapidity, and mineral character.

production:

4,600 bottles.
